The restriction is applied across both the Main Draw and Qualifying competition to provide for a maximum total of six (6) players in any combination (i.e., 4 Qualifying / 2 Main Draw or 1 Qualifying / 5 Main Draw).

Doubles events

- Each Member Association shall be allowed a maximum of eight (8) players per event but only three (3) full pair consisting of players from the same Member Association (i.e., 3 CHN/CHN, 1 CHN/AUS, 1 CHN/GER). The Host is permitted to use its wildcards to nominate additional players full or half pairs outside of the NER limit.

Mixed Doubles events
